Every member of the Company present online (in the case of a member being a corporation, by its duly authorized representative), or by proxy online shall have one vote for every fully paid share of which he/she/it is the holder. A person entitled to more than one vote need not use all his/her votes or cast all the votes in the same way and in such cases, please state the relevant number of shares in the appropriate box(es) above.
- This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorized in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be either executed under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney or other person duly authorized.
- In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, online or by proxy online, will be accepted to the exclusion of votes of the other joint holder(s) and for this purpose seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the Register of Members of the Company in respect of the joint holding.
