**VOLUNTARY ANNOUNCEMENT ON
ENTERING INTO ALIBABA CLOUD MSP
COOPERATION AGREEMENT**

This announcement is voluntarily made by AsiaInfo Technologies Limited (the “**Company**”) and its subsidiaries (collectively referred to as the “**Group**”) to inform the shareholders (the “**Shareholders**”) and potential investors of the Company about the latest business development of the Group.

The “Alibaba Cloud MSP Cooperation Scheme” refers to a cooperation scheme under which Alibaba Cloud and the managed service provider will work jointly in such areas to provide service business opportunities, industry solutions and cloud management services.

Alibaba Cloud is a global leading technology company in cloud computing and artificial intelligence, which serves millions of customers from over 200 countries and regions worldwide, and provides services for more than half of A-share listed companies and 80% of China’s technology innovation enterprises. The Group is a leading software product, solution and service provider in the PRC with intensive engagement in the telecom operators market for over two decades, and is capable of offering various large-scale software products, service integration, operation and maintenance as well as customized business.

Cloud computing and enterprises cloudification are important changes and trend of information development. Pursuant to the Cooperation Agreement, the Group and Alibaba Cloud will combine the advantages of both sides, formulate joint solutions that cater to the targeted vertical industries, and work together to provide cloud service business for enterprise users to advance enterprises cloudification and facilitate their digital transformation via cloud technology.
