**THE ISSUE OF ULTRA SHORT-TERM COMMERCIAL PAPER
IN THE PRC BY WUHAN SHENGZE JIETONG LOGISTICS CO., LTD.,
A WHOLLY-OWNED SUBSIDIARY OF THE COMPANY**

The Board of directors of China ZhengTong Auto Services Holdings Limited (the “Company”) (the “Board”) is pleased to announce that Wuhan Shengze Jietong Logistics Co., Ltd. (the “Issuer”), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, has completed the issue of the second tranche of ultra short-term commercial paper for the year 2016 (the “Ultra Short-term Commercial Paper”) in the PRC on 2 September 2016. The aggregate principal amount of the Ultra Short-term Commercial Paper is RMB350 million, at the interest rate of 5.49% per annum, and with a term of 270 days. Both the par value and the issuing price of the Ultra Short-term Commercial Paper are RMB100 per unit.

The net proceeds from the issue of the Ultra Short-term Commercial Paper are intended to be used for repayment of bank loans.
